IMPORTANT NOTE: Come in the entrance on Route 22 ONLY.

Park in the Upper Parking Lot

From the North: From I-287 (Cross Westchester Expy)

At exit 9S-N, take Ramp (right) Westchester Ave. towards Hutchinson Pkwy/Whitestone Blvd/Ment Pkwy.

At 9S, take Ramp (right) onto Hutchinson River Pkwy South towards Hutchinson Pkwy/Whitestone Br

At exit 18W, keep RIGHT onto ramp towards Mill Road West/Eastchester Bear RIGHT onto Mill Rd. At the 5th traffic light make a left onto White Plains Rd.

(Route 22). After 3 traffic lights, look for the entrance on your right. Park in the upper lot on the right. Use the grass if necessary.

From the South: (including Long Island)

Whitestone Br. onto Hutchinson River Pkwy N towards Hutchinson Pkwy

North/New Rochelle:

At exit 13, take ramp (RIGHT) onto Cross County Pkwy towards Cross County Pkwy/Saw Mill Pkwy/Nonkers

At exit 8, keep RIGHT onto ramp towards Route 22/N Columbus Ave./Mt. Vernon

Take ramp (LEFT) onto Route 22 (North Columbus Ave) towards Route 22

Keep straight on Route 22/White Plains Rd. approximately 3 miles.

Make a left into parking lot from White Plains Rd. Park in the upper lot on the right. Use the grass if necessary.

Smoking, food and beverages are permitted in designated areas ONLY
